Preamble:

The World CBRN and Medical Congress (CEBIRAM) would like to follow up on the successful FFF 2016 edition.

As of today, we are facing evolving threats from both state and non-state actors that includes range of complex challenges, including hybrid warfare, terrorism, cyber-attacks, migration, highly contagious disease and wide range of events involving weapons of mass destruction (WMD), chemical, biological, radiological, and nuclear (CBRN) and health threats.

Civil-military cooperation and crisis preparedness of all stakeholders in medical and CBRN areas are to be crucial after significant security challenges over the world during past years.

Part of discussion will be focused on new forms of force health support and protection, tools and techniques for field medical training including non-military medical facility readiness, and new advances in medical research and development.

The full extent of the potential CBRN threats cannot be predicted because these threats can evolve in non-linear ways, and can be affected by a number of outside factors, including meteorological conditions, economy (Toxic Industrial Threats), flow of goods and people, etc. Such uncertainty can make it difficult to determine the nature or origin of such a threat, and complicate responses efforts when detailed information is not yet available.

Effective responses to CBRN crisis events often require the initiation of a response before the origin or full extent of the event is understood, which requires familiarity with various aspects of diverse scenarios that can only be achieved through advanced consideration. Advance planning together with the flexibility for a wide range of future CBRN response efforts.

Concept Development and Experimentation (CD&E) is a relatively new trend within NATO Medical Arena, which comprised mutually supportive activities, relevant to NATO's transformational process in order to support MED Capability Development. CD&E has proven high potential to ensure that newly developed NATO concepts are being exercised/tested across the full capability requirement spectrum.

Exercise VIGOROUS WARRIOR 2017 (VW'17) engaged military medical elements from 28 NATO/ PfP Nations in an effort to train develop and enhance NATO's scarce capabilities. It created an excellent opportunity to perform MED CD&E Activities for the first time ever, during LIVEX.

There were three identified themes for VW'17 Experimentation Activities, strongly supported by the NATO Centre of Excellence for Military Medicine (MILMED CoE):

- a. Interoperability/Modularity
- b. Civ/Mil cooperation interface
- c. Bio responsiveness




